

POWER OF SIN BROKEN — ROMANS 6

♥ ROMANS 6:1-14

In Christ the power of sin is broken because we have a new LIFE

Opens with a question (v.1) — Answers the Christian's Relation to Sin

≡ “What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin that grace may abound?” (Ro.6:1)

» Deals with grace not being used as a license to sin

1. We have new LIFE (v.8, 11, 13)
2. We have died to sin (v.3-6)
3. We have been united to Christ in His resurrection (v.5)

♥ ROMANS 6:15-23

In Christ the power of sin is broken because we have a new LORD

Opens with a question (v.15) — Answers the Christian's Relation to Sin

≡ “What then? Shall we sin because we are not under law but under grace? Certainly not!” (Ro.6:15)

» Deals with grace not being used as legalism to sin

1. We have a new LORD (Master, i.e., God, v.17)
2. Whoever is our master we obey (v.16)
3. Now righteousness is the rule of our lives (v.18, 22)
