FACTS SHOWING THE ISSUES - ROMANS 9-11

- **FACT 1:** The Israelites are <u>God's chosen people</u> (**Du.7:6, 7, 8, 9; Ro 11:28**)
- **FACT 2:** God promised His chosen people that they would enjoy a glorious <u>kingdom</u> under their Messiah (**Da**.7:13, 14; Is.2:1, 2, 3,4, 5; 9:6, 7; 11:1-9; Je.23:5, 6, 7, 8; 31:31-37; 33:14, 15, 16; Lk.1:32, 33)
- **FACT 3:** The nation of Israel (at least the majority) <u>rejected their Messiah</u> when He came (Jn.1:11; Mt.12:22-24; 21:33-46; 27:22-25; Jn.19:15; Ac.22:22; 1Th.2:14-15)
- **FACT 4:** When the church began it was made up entirely of Jewish believers (Ac.2). This changed as <u>more Gentiles and less Jews</u> entered the church (Ro.11:25)

Fact 1 and 2 seem to be contradicted by fact 3 and 4

SSUES

- Thought of a first century Jew:
 - 1. The gospel Paul preached IS NOT true, thus Jesus is not the Messiah. They must wait for the true Messiah to come to setup the kingdom.
 - 2. The gospel Paul preached IS true and Jesus is indeed the Messiah.
 - Then why is there no kingdom?
 - Has God cast away His people?
