## 'HINGS CONCERNING RESURRECTION — 1

## The Evidence of the Resurrection

A. The Existence of the Church — v.1-2

<sup>1</sup>Moreover, brethren, I declare to you the gospel which I preached to you, which also you received and in which you stand, <sup>2</sup>by which also you are saved, if you hold fast that word which I preached to you—unless you believed in vain (1Co.15:1-2).

B. The OT Validates the Resurrection — v.3

For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, (1Co.15:3)

C. There are Personal Witnesses — v.5-11

<sup>5</sup>and that He was seen by Cephas, then by the twelve. <sup>6</sup>After that He was seen by over five hundred brethren at once, of whom the greater part remain to the present, but some have fallen asleep. After that He was seen by James, then by all the apostles. <sup>8</sup>Then last of all He was seen by me also, as by one born out of due time. (1Co.15:5-8)

The Importance of the Resurrection

1Co.15:12-19

<sup>12</sup>Now if Christ is preached that He has been raised from the dead, how do some among you say that there is no resurrection of the dead? (1Co.15:12)

The Sequence of the Resurrecti

1Co.15:20.23

<sup>20</sup>But now Christ is risen from the dead, and has become the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. <sup>23</sup>But each one in his own order: Christ the firstfruits, afterward those who are Christ's at His coming. (1Co.15:20.23)

The Body of the Resurrection

1Co.15:42-44

A. It Will Be Incorruptible — v.42

So also is the resurrection of the dead. The body is sown in corruption, it is raised in incorruption. (1Co.15:42)

B. It Will Be Glorified — v.43, "raised in glory"

It is sown in dishonor, it is raised in glory. It is sown in weakness, it is raised in power. (1Co.15:43)

C. It Will Be Powerful — v.43, "raised in power"

D. It Will Be Spiritual — v.44

It is sown a natural body, it is raised a spiritual body. There is a natural body, and there is a spiritual body. (1Co.15:44)

The Event of the Resurrection

<sup>51</sup>Behold, I tell you a mystery: We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed—<sup>52</sup>in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. (1Co.15:51-52)

The Victory of the Resurrection

1Co.15:54-55

<sup>54</sup>So when this corruptible has put on incorruption, and this mortal has put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written: "DEATH IS SWALLOWED UP IN VICTORY. 55"O DEATH, WHERE IS YOUR STING? O HADES, WHERE IS YOUR VICTORY?" — (1Co.15:54-55)
