Enoch Believed That God Is

- This is where faith begins.
- It is not saying, 'He must believe that there is a God.'
- You must believe that the God who claims to be God, is God.
- It is not your version of God. It is His version of Himself as revealed in His Word.
- When you come to God, all of a sudden the truth is there because you know Him.



Enoch Was Seeking God's Reward

- You must believe you need the reward (salvation) He offers.
- Enoch believed God is personal and moral.
- You must come to God on His terms. His terms or standard are righteous.

"he who comes to God must believe that He is" (**He.11:6**)



"and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him" (He.11:6)

Enoch Was Walking With God

- To walk with God involves reconciliation. We walk together in agreement.
- To walk with God involves a new divine nature which allows us to have communion.
- To walk with God involves a moral fitness (holiness) so we can be in His presence without offence.
- To walk with God involves a surrendered will. "This is love, that we walk according to His commandments" (2Jn.1:6)

Enoch Was Preaching For God

- When you walk in the Spirit it affects the way you affect others.
- Enoch pleased God because his faith was active.
- Enoch preached hell-fire and damnation for God. He let them know they were ungodly.

Enoch Entered God's Presence

- The result of believing, seeking, walking, and preaching is he entered God's presence.
- Enoch is a wonderful picture of the believers who will be alive on the earth when Jesus descends in the air to catch His bride away. He was an ancient picture of the rapture.
- God enjoys the fellowship of His saints.

"Enoch walked with God" (Ge.5:22,24)

"to execute judgment on all, to convict all (Jd.1:25)

"By faith Enoch was taken away" (He.11:5)

"God took him" (Ge.5:24)

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
