

COMMANDS OF CHRIST



- 01 **Repent** - “Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand” (Mt.4:17)
- 02 **Follow Him** - “Then He said to them, “Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men” (Mt.4:19)
- 03 **Let your light shine** - “Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven” (Mt.5:16)
- 04 **Don’t Lust** - “everyone who looks at a woman with lust for her has already committed adultery with her in his heart” (Mt.5:27-30)
- 05 **Be reconciled** - “First be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift” (Mt.5:23-24)
- 06 **Don’t resist evil with evil** - “I tell you not to resist an evil person. But whoever slaps you on your right cheek, turn the other to him also” (Mt.5:39-42)
- 07 **Love and pray for your enemies** - “I say to you, love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you” (Mt.5:44-46)
- 08 **Be perfect (in love)** - “Therefore you shall be perfect, just as your Father in heaven is perfect” (Mt.5:48)
- 09 **Seek God’s Kingdom first** - “But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you” (Mt.6:33)
- 10 **Don’t give what is holy to dogs** - “Do not give what is holy to the dogs; nor cast your pearls before swine” (Mt.7:6)
- 11 **Treat people as you want to be treated** - “whatever you want men to do to you, do also to them, for this is the Law and the Prophets” (Mt.7:12)
- 12 **Follow Jesus** - “But Jesus said to him, “Follow Me, and let the dead bury their own dead.”” (Mt.8:22)
- 13 **Ask God to send out workers** - “pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest” (Mt.9:37-38)
- 14 **Come to Jesus for rest** - “Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest” (Mt.11:28)
- 15 **Confront brothers in private first** - “if your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone” (Mt.18:15–17)
- 16 **Forgive Seventy times Seven** - “I do not say to you, up to seven times, but up to seventy times seven” (Mt.18:21–22)
- 17 **Render to Caesar what is Caesar’s** - “Render therefore to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's” (Mt.22:21)
- 18 **Love God** - “You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind” (Mt.22:37–38)
- 19 **Love your Neighbor** - “And the second is like it: ‘You shall love your neighbor as yourself’” (Mt.22:39)
- 20 **Partake of Communion** - “²⁶Take, eat; this is My body. ²⁷Drink from it, all of you” (Mt.26:26-27)
- 21 **Keep guard against sin** - “Watch and pray, lest you enter into temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak” (Mt.26:41)
- 22 **Make Disciples** - “¹⁹Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations... ²⁰teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you” (Mt.28:19-20)
- 23 **Preach the Gospel** - “Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature” (Mk.16:15)
- 24 **Invite the poor** - “when you give a reception, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind...they do not have the means to repay you” (Lk.14:12-14)
- 25 **Love one another** - “This is My commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you” (Jn.15:12)
