## ELEMENTS OF HOPE – DOCTRINE

## We Have a Hope That...

- Comes From God (Ps.43:5; 78:7)
  - "Why are you cast down, O my soul? And why are you disquieted within me? <u>Hope in God</u>; For I shall yet praise Him, The help of my countenance and my God" (**Ps.43:5**).

SOURCE

- 2 Is Given To Us By Grace (2Th.2:16)
  - "Now may our Lord Jesus Christ Himself, and our God and Father, who has loved us and given us everlasting consolation and good hope by grace" (2Th.2:16).

THROUGH

- 3 Is Laid Out For Us in Scripture (Ro.15:4; Ps.119:81)
  - "For whatever things were written before were written for our learning, that we through the patience and <u>comfort of the Scriptures might have hope</u>" (Ro.15:4). "My soul faints for Your salvation, But <u>I hope in Your word</u>" (Ps.119:81). **TREASURE**
- Is Objectively Defensible (1Pe.3:15).
  - "But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts, and always be ready to give a defense to everyone who asks you a <u>reason for the hope</u> that is in you, with meekness and fear" (1Pe.3:15).

**MESSAGE** 

- 5 Has Already Been Secured For Us By the Resurrection (1Pe.1:3; Jn.14:19)
  - "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a <u>living hope through the resurrection</u> of Jesus Christ from the dead" (1Pe.1:3).

- [6] Is Confirmed By the Work of the Holy Spirit In Us (Ro.15:13)
  - "Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit" (Ro.15:13).

- **7** Defends Against the Doubts of Satan (1Th.5:8)
  - "But let us who are of the day be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love, and as a <u>helmet the hope of salvation</u>" (1Th.5:8).

## **HOPE AS A MOTIVE FOR HOLINESS**

- "And everyone who has <u>this hope</u> in Him purifies himself, just as <u>He is pure</u>" (**1Jn.3:3; 2Tm.4:1; 1Co.4:5**).

  Living with the expectation of Christ's return is a critical element in motivating us to holiness.
- "This hope we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and steadfast, and which enters the Presence behind the veil" (**He.6:19**). Hope is an anchor that is tied to Christ who is interceding for us (**He.6:19**)
