

JOHN “IN THE SPIRIT”

EARTH
PATMOS

“I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day” (Rv.1:10)

It was on the Lord's Day that John received his first vision. He is on the isle Patmos. John hears a voice like a **trumpet**. It is **JESUS** speaking.

HEAVEN

“And immediately I was in the spirit” (Rv.4:2)

John is transported to Heaven for a vision. There he sees the Father, Son and Holy Spirit in Heaven. John hears a voice like a **trumpet** say, “**Come up hither**”. It is **JESUS** speaking.

EARTH
WILDERNESS

“So he carried me away in the spirit into the wilderness” (Rv.17:3)

John goes into the wilderness to see another vision. John hears **ONE OF THE 7 ANGELS** say, “**Come hither**”. John sees the Mother of Harlots, the great religious and commercial system.

EARTH
MOUNTAIN

“And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain” (Rv.21:10)

John was carried by **THE SPIRIT** to a high mountain where he saw the New Jerusalem.

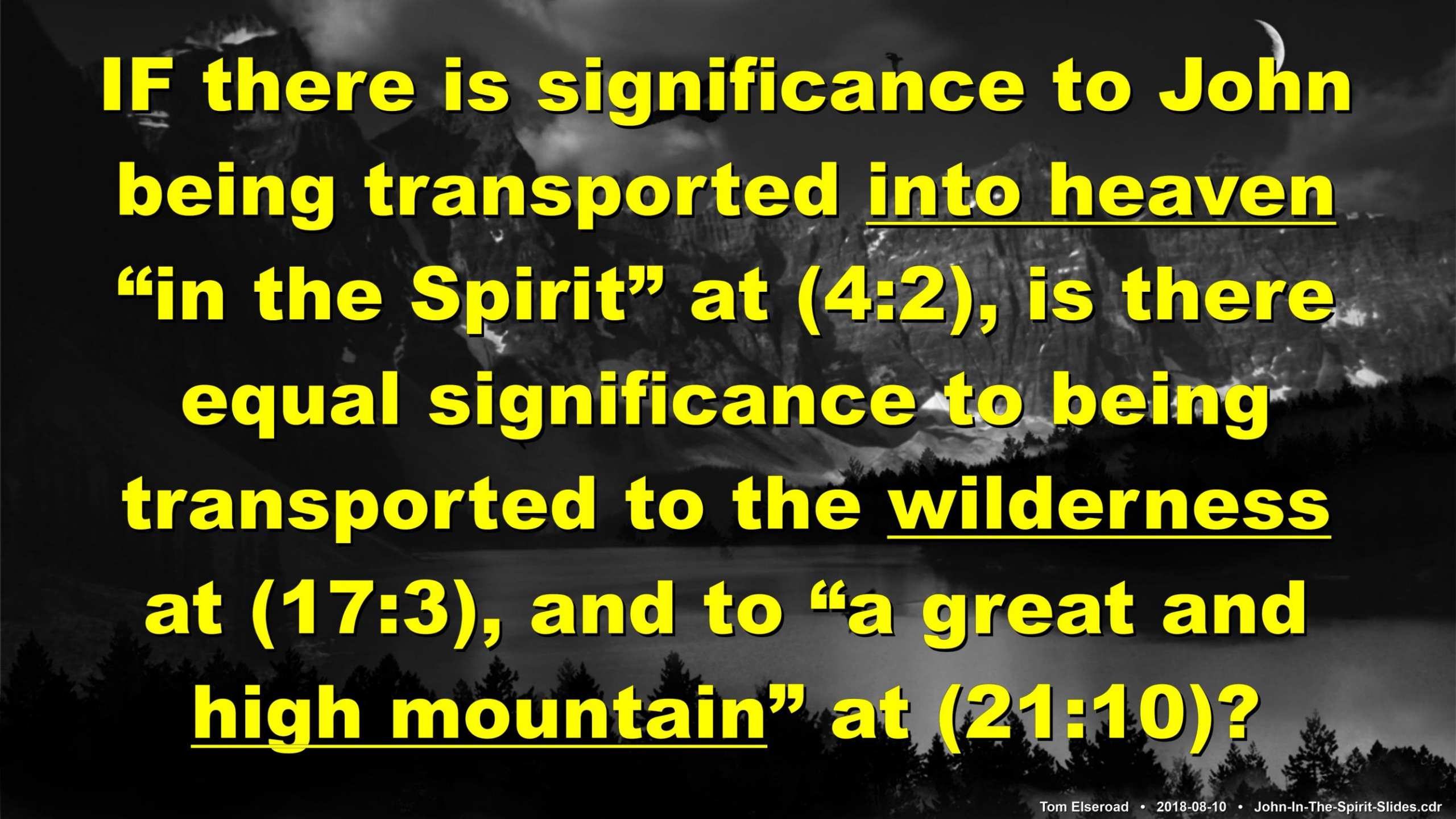
DIFFERENT VISION SCENES

There are 4 vision scenes with John said to be “in the spirit” (1:10; 4:2; 17:3; 21:10)

Two vision scenes include Jesus speaking like a trumpet to John (1:10; 4:1)

JESUS (4:1) and one of the 7 JUDGMENT ANGELS (17:1) call John to “come”

The scene in Heaven does not change until the Lamb begins to open the 7 seals (Rv.6:1)

high mountain” at (21:10)?**
