THE THOUSAND YEAR PROMISE

¹Then I saw an angel coming down from heaven, having the key to the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand. ²He laid hold of the dragon, that serpent of old, who is the Devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years; ³and he cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal on him, so that he should deceive the nations no more till the thousand years were finished. But after these things he must be released for a little while.

THE THOUSAND YEAR PROMISE

⁴And I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was committed to them. Then I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for their witness to Jesus and for the word of God, who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received his mark on their foreheads or on their hands. And they lived and reigned with Christ for a thousand years. ⁵But the rest of the dead did not live again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection. ⁶Blessed and holy is he who has part in the first resurrection. Over such the second death has no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with Him a thousand years. ⁷Now when the thousand years have expired, Satan will be released from his prison

LITERAL OR ALLEGORICAL?

- ❖ **The fact that this 1,000 year period is referred to 6 times in 7 verses tells us this is likely an actual period of 1,000 years, and not an allegory for “an unknown or long period of time.”**
- ❖ **If God wanted to communicate “a long time,” He certainly could have done so without repeatedly mentioning the exact time frame.**
- ❖ **The fulfillment of many of God’s covenants and promises rests on a literal, physical, future kingdom.**

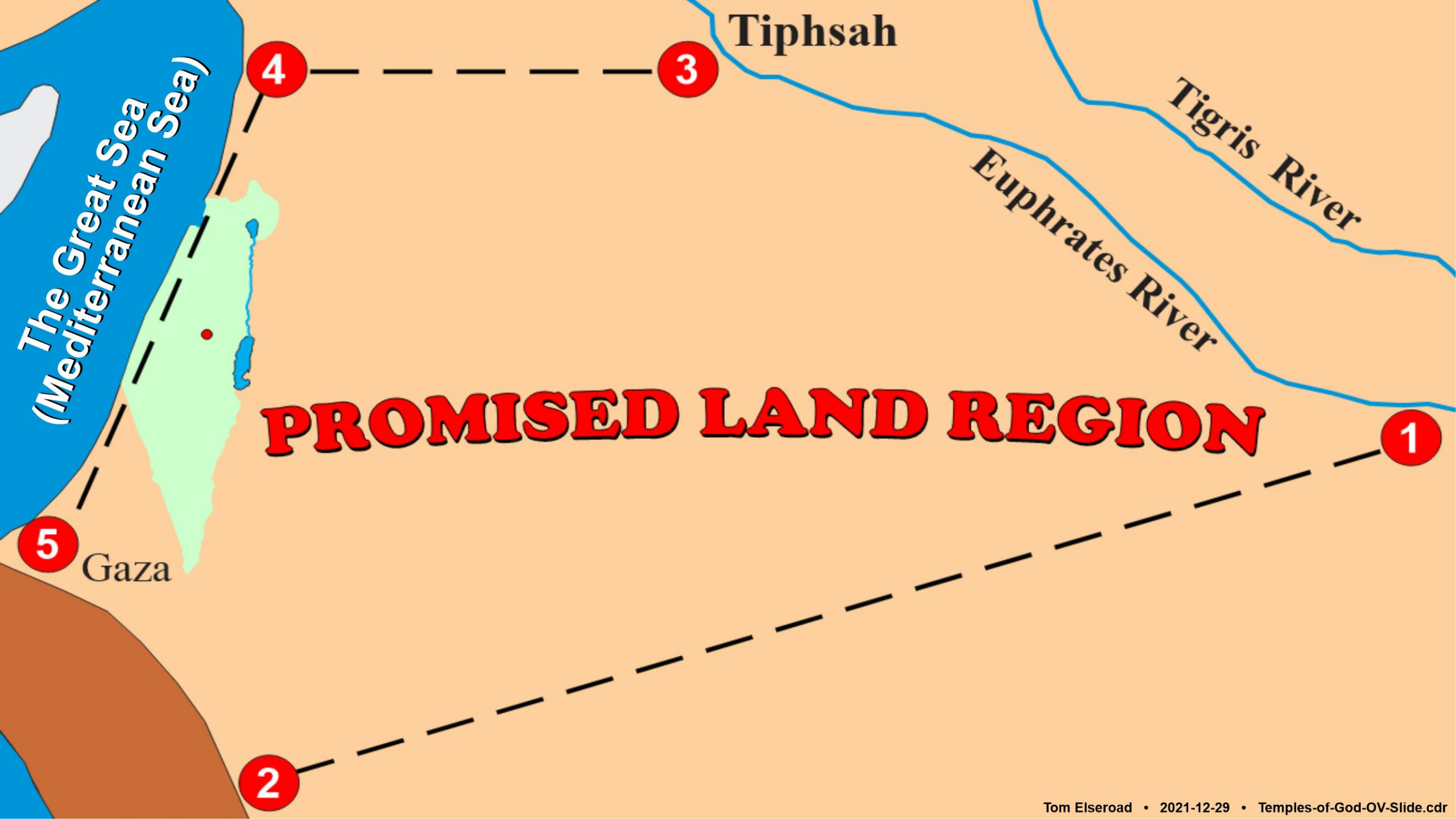

GOD WILL FULFILL PROMISES MADE TO ISRAEL

Spiritual Promise (Je.31:31-34)

³¹"Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah— ³²not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, though I was a husband to them, says the LORD. ³³But this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the LORD: I will put My law in their minds, and write it on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. ³⁴No more shall every man teach his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying, 'Know the LORD,' for they all shall know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them, says the LORD. 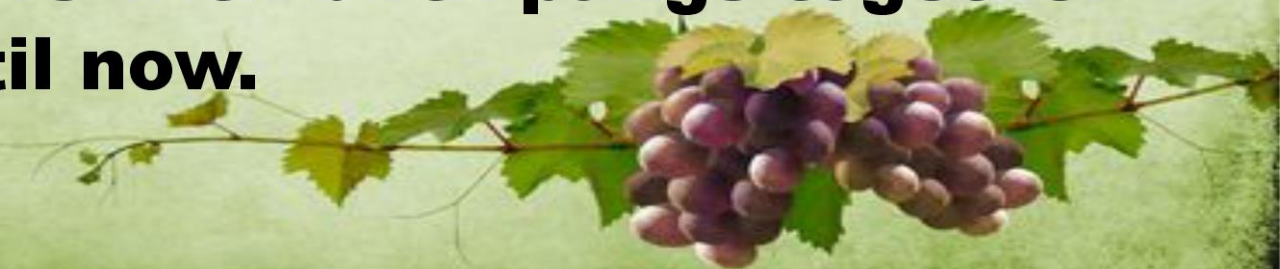


GOD WILL FULFILL PROMISES MADE TO CREATION

¹⁸For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us. ¹⁹For the earnest expectation of the creation eagerly waits for the revealing of the sons of God. ²⁰For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of Him who subjected it in hope; ²¹because the creation itself also will be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God. ²²For we know that the whole creation groans and labors with birth pangs together until now.

PROMISES 4

PROMISES 4

- ❖ **When Adam and Eve sinned it contaminated the human race, but also a curse was placed upon the creation**
- ❖ **God will reverse the curse He placed on creation**
- ❖ **We know there has never been a time in history where you could play with snakes, bears, and lions, except before the Fall of man (Ge.1-2)**
- ❖ **When God reverses the curse on creation we will enjoy creation in the way God intended for us to enjoy it.**

Jesus Announces His Kingdom (Rv.11:15)
