1 MOSES AND JOSHUA

1446BC — 1399BC

47 Years

- EXAMPLES
- MOSES at the Red Sea (Ex.14:31)
 - JOSHUA at the crossing of the Jordan (Js.3:7)

“But, indeed, for this reason I have allowed you to remain, in order to show you My power and in order to proclaim My name through all the earth.” (Ex.9:16)

Giving of the Law

- Miracles Introduce New Era of revelation
- They call attention to the revelation

PURPOSE: 1. Show God's power through Moses 2. Declare God's name to all the earth 3. Discredit Egyptian gods

2 ELIJAH AND ELISHA

874BC — 840BC

34 Years

- EXAMPLES
- ELIJAH [16 miracles] (1Ki.17:24)
 - ELISHA [32 miracles] (2Ki.4:1—6:7)

“Answer me, O LORD, answer me, that this people may know that You, O LORD, are God, and that You have turned their heart back again.” (1Ki.18:37)

Ministry of the Prophets

- Miracles Introduce New Era of revelation
- They call attention to the revelation

PURPOSE: 1. Know that the LORD is God 2. Turn their hearts to the LORD

3 JESUS AND APOSTLES

29AD — 60AD

31 Years

- EXAMPLES
- JESUS' Ministry (Jn.20:30-31; Ac.2:22)
 - APOSTLES' Ministry (2Co.12:12; He.2:3-4)

“God also testifying with them, both by signs and wonders and by various miracles and by gifts of the Holy Spirit according to His own will.” (He.2:4)

Inauguration of the New Testament

- Miracles Introduce New Era of revelation
- They call attention to the revelation

PURPOSE: 1. Testify the authenticity of God's messengers 2. To confirm the truthfulness of the gospel message 3. Give evidence that God is at work 4. To bring glory to God
